Then water in to a depth of 4 to 6 inches. To obtain even application, blend **Tru-Green® Iron Chelate** with a granular fertilizer or inert such as sand, or dissolve in water and spray or sprinkle on soil.

**SPECIAL APPLICATIONS**

**ORNAMENTAL TREES:** Soil: For each inch of trunk diameter apply 2 oz. (6 Tbsp.) to trees up to 5 inches in diameter. Over 5 inches in diameter apply 8 oz. per each inch. Foliage Spray: 2 Tbsp. per gallon of water.

**FRUIT TREES:** Soil: Apply 2 oz. (6 Tbsp.) per each inch of trunk diameter. Foliage Spray: 1 Tbsp. per gallon of water.

2 teaspoons per plant	Roses	1 Tablespoon per 1 gal water
1 teaspoon per plant	Snappedragons	Suggest soil application
4 teaspoons per plant	Shrubs	Suggest soil application
2 Tablespoons per 150 sq ft of soil area	Vegetables	1 Tablespoon per 1 gal water (apply 4 weeks after planting)

**Note:** The above is only a partial listing. **Tru-Green® Iron Chelate** may be used on all growing plants.

**LAWN GRASS:** As a Spray: 1 Tbsp. per gallon of water or fluid, applied to 10 square feet. May be added to any liquid or soluble fertilizer.

**POTTED HOUSE PLANTS:** Quantities fluctuate. As a rule, allow 1/2 tsp. per plant. Mix in small amount of water and apply to roots. Increase amount if necessary in relation to plant size, delicacy, and potting medium.
