Lilly Miller COMPOST MAKER helps turn all sorts of garden clippings into rich humus that improves your garden soil. Lilly Miller blends 100% natural organic ingredients for this special mix. It is great for heating up compost piles for quick breakdown.

Composting your garden trimmings is one of the best things you can do for your garden, and it keeps waste out of landfills. Use compost in your garden to loosen clay soils, improve moisture retention in sandy soil, make fertilizers more available to plants, and to help grow vigorous disease-resistant plants. Mix a few inches of compost into the top 6-10 inches of soil in garden beds before planting, or spread an inch or two as a mulch each year on established plants.

HOW DO I USE THIS PRODUCT?

WHEN TO USE: Add Lilly Miller Compost Maker to all new compost piles. Mix it into old piles when turning to aerate or moisten.

WHAT TO DO: Sprinkle 2 cups of Lilly Miller Compost Maker on top of each 3-6 inch layer added to a 3 feet wide by 3 feet long compost pile. Spray each layer with water from a garden hose until everything glistens with moisture.

THE CLASSIC COMPOST PILE:

To make hot compost piles that break down quickly (4-8 weeks) and generate enough heat to destroy weed seeds and pests:

- Gather enough fresh yard trimmings to make a pile 3 feet high by 3 feet wide and long, or larger. Use a variety of clippings, including soft greens and brown leaves or twigs.
- Chop coarse materials into small pieces using a machete or garden shredder.
- Add 3 to 6 inch layers of trimmings at a time, alternating green and brown materials.
- Mix 2 cups of Compost Maker with each layer of garden trimmings and spray with water from a garden hose until everything glistens with moisture.
- Add a thin layer (1/8"-1/4") of garden soil

or old compost between layers of garden trimmings.

- Use up all of the trimmings, and top the pile with 1-2 inches of garden soil.
- Allow the pile to heat up and start to cool, usually 7-10 days. Pull the pile apart and restack, putting trimmings from the top and sides into the bottom and middle of the new pile. Moisten dry materials as you turn. If the pile did not heat up well (it should be too hot to stick your hand into the middle), mix 2 cups of Compost Maker with each layer as you restack.
- Turn again in a week or two. Allow to cure for at least 2 weeks before using in the garden.
